Abstract submission

Please send your English abstract to imf@mail.las.ac.cn prior to **June 15th, 2022**.

See Sample Abstract for the requirements.

When writing your abstract, it is recommended that you may indicate a preference for presentation in a topical session, the Scientific Advisor Committee will make the final decision as to how the abstract is to be presented.

Acceptance of papers & Full-text submission

Abstracts will be considered under the peer review process. The IMF2022 scientific advisory committee (SAC) will organize all accepted abstracts into either oral or poster based upon their potential contribution to the forum.

Acceptance letters will send to the first author of the abstract by email before **July 15th, 2022**.

The keynote speech and oral presentations should submit a scientific manuscript (Full paper) to imf@mail.las.ac.cn by attachment before **July 30th, 2022**.

Please review and use the template (in MS-Word Format) prior to preparing your submissions.

Presentations

Poster—Posters (Presentation PDF) can be presented without an accompanying proceedings paper and will be available online on this website during and after the e-conference. To present a poster, regular abstract submission guidelines should be followed.

Slides—Authors are encouraged to prepare a presentation in PowerPoint or similar software, to be displayed online along with the Manuscript. Slides, if available, will be displayed directly in the website using zoom. Slides can be prepared in exactly the same way as for any traditional conference where research results can be presented. Slides should be converted to the PDF format before submission so that our process can easily and automatically convert them for online displaying.

Video—Authors are encouraged to submit video presentations. This is an unique way of presenting your paper and discussing it with peers from all over the world. The video should be no longer than 5 minutes and prepared with one of the following formats: .mp4 / .webm / .ogg (max size: 250Mb). It should be submitted directly to the conference platform before 31 July 2022. Make a difference and join us for this project!
